We are all aware of the problems of excess drinking and how it can sometimes affect our lives or the lives of someone we all know.

Because of public concerns regarding violence and disorder with an emphasis towards drink related causes the Chief Constable of Sussex has initiated a force wide campaign called 'Enough is Enough'. Horsham police are asking members of NHW to report any signs of underage drinking which may be where an older person has gone into a shop, off licence or pub to purchase alcohol for another. You may see a group of young people causing anti social behaviour possibly caused by the consumption of too much alcohol, they may not necessarily be under age but are seen loitering near an establishment where alcohol can be purchased or consumed.

To assist the Police in reducing these alcohol related problems in your area, which will include your local shops the Police would encourage you to report it by ringing the non-emergency number **0845 60 70 999** **immediately stating your call is in connection with the Enough is Enough campaign**. The Police cannot do this by themselves, they need your assistance. There is and will be visits to licensed premises and local shops by Police officers and licensing officers on the run up to New Years Eve. Let us all work together to say, Enough **IS** Enough and maybe we can all contribute to making a difference.
